

Hooray! The Evil Pea has finally been stopped and is trapped inside the jelly.


Was your prediction correct?



We have looked at a number of 2D shapes and their properties.




We have looked at straight sides, curved sides and vertices (corners).

Remember a curved side is like a circle and a straight side can be vertical, horizontal or diagonal.




