


How to make a Dino Spot book?

Dinosaurs are fascinating creates, they lived millions of years ago and are now extinct. We still find evidence of them in the ground today.


When living things are buried deep under ground for a long time they turn into fossils, this means they leave a pattern/impression in the rock. The pictures to the right are just two examples.




