#### **Year 1 Addition and Subtraction Word Problems**

#### **Problem 1: Basic Counting**

Tommy has 5 toy football players. If he receives 3 more toys on his birthday, how many toy football players does he have now?

#### **Problem 2: Simple Addition**

Ella has 4 Disney princess dolls. If her friend gives her 2 more dolls, how many Disney princess dolls does Ella have in total?

#### **Problem 3: Basic Subtraction**

In a football match, there were 9 players on one team. If 3 players had to leave the match, how many players are left on that team?

#### Problem 4: Addition with Context

At the Disney party, there are 7 balloons. If 6 more balloons are added, how many balloons are there now at the party?

#### Problem 5: Subtracting from a Total

Liam had 10 football stickers. He traded 4 of them with his friends. How many football stickers does Liam have left?

#### Problem 6: Combining Interests

Amelia has 8 party hats for her Disney-themed birthday party. If 3 more hats are made by her friends, how many party hats does she have altogether?

#### Problem 7: Mixed Addition and Subtraction

During a football game, there were 12 fans cheering in the stands. If 5 fans leave the game but 4 more fans arrive, how many fans are in the stands now?

#### Problem 8: Challenge with Multiple Steps

At a Disney party, there are 15 children playing games. If 6 of them leave to get snacks, but then 3 more children arrive to join, how many children are playing games now?

#### Problem 9: Real-Life Context with Change

If there were 18 footballs in the gym and 7 were borrowed by the school's football team, how many footballs are left in the gym?

#### **Problem 10: Advanced Mixed Operations**

At a Disney party, there are 14 cupcakes. If 5 cupcakes are eaten, and then 4 more cupcakes are brought out, how many cupcakes are there now at the party?

#### Year 2 Maths Word Problems: Addition and Subtraction within 100

Basic Addition: Lucy has 15 football stickers. She buys 12 more stickers at a shop. How many stickers does Lucy have now?

Basic Subtraction: There are 40 balloons at a Disney party. 18 balloons burst during the party. How many balloons are left?

Intermediate Addition: A football match has 25 fans on one side and 20 fans on the other. How many fans are there altogether?

Intermediate Subtraction: Tom had 70 chocolate cupcakes for a Disney-themed party. He gave 15 cupcakes to his friends. How many cupcakes does Tom have left?

Addition with Larger Numbers: At a football training session, 32 children were present in the morning and 28 in the afternoon. How many children came to training that day?

Subtraction with Larger Numbers: There are 85 toy cars in a Disney shop. If 24 cars are sold, how many toy cars are still in the shop?

Addition: A football team scored 45 goals in the first half of the season and 32 goals in the second half. How many goals did the team score in total?

Problem: Sarah is organising a Disney party. She invites 36 children to the party. If 9 cannot attend, how many children will be at the party?

Problem with Context:A football club has 65 season tickets remaining. If 20 new season tickets are sold and then 15 are returned, how many season tickets does the club have left?
