A suffix is a letter or group of letters that goes on the end of a word and changes the word's meaning.

Some suffixes have specific uses. For example:

- Adding -ing can change a noun into a werb, like garden to garden ing.
- Using the suffix -ed can change a verb to the past tense, like jump which becomes jumped.
