- · The genie-you could use your own genie that you made in yesterday's session


Before you write a story, it is important that you spend time planning your ideas. Authors do not just simply begin to write their story books-they take time to think about their ideas and map out the events.

In tomorrow's lesson, you will use this story map to support you in writing your own story.





Part-Whole Model


