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Nelson St Philip's C of E Primary School Remote Education Home School Agreement

At St Philip's, we understand that remote education cannot replace children being educated in school and we are fully aware of the difficulties this may bring to you as parents/carers. More than ever before, we really do need to work together in order to prevent the children missing out on any further learning, which is vital to their overall development.

Please can you read and then sign the following 'Remote Education Home School Agreement', which sets out our expectations for the school, parents/carers and children:

As a school we will:

- Set work for every child, Monday to Friday, with the work matched as closely as possible to the curriculum that would be taught in school.
- Ensure that teachers will be available from 9am to 4.15pm, Monday to Friday and that work set for pupils is accessible on the website from 9am every morning, Monday to Friday.
- Read and reply to emails sent by parents/carers, if their child is struggling with their understanding of the tasks set.
- Check the work that children complete on a daily basis, as it is returned to school by the parent/carer, giving feedback where necessary.
- Keep a running record of children completing the work set, on a daily basis and teachers will send reminders (via email) to the parents/carers of the children who do not send in their work, before the beginning of the following school day.
- Contact parents/carers on the Friday of each week, if the required amount of work has not been completed by the children (email/phone call/house visit).

As a parent/carer:

- I understand the importance of supporting my child in completing the daily activities that my child's teacher has set and I will do my best to help them to understand and complete the work.
- I will email the class teacher if my child needs further support in understanding any of the tasks set.
- I will do my best to ensure that my child completes the majority or all of the work, which my child's teacher has uploaded to the school website, or the pack of work that I collect from school each day.
- I will take photographs of the work completed and send these to the class teacher via email on a daily basis, or return the pack of work to school, so that my child's work can be checked. I

understand that this work maybe returned, so that my child can read the teacher's comments and have another try at correcting some mistakes.

Expectations of the children:

- Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are expected to work on average, up to three hours each day (with short breaks between each task).
- Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 children are expected to work on average, up to four hours each day (with short breaks between each task).
- The children are to focus on the core subjects of Reading, Writing and Maths first and then to complete the tasks set for the foundation subjects.
- Work must be completed to the same high standard expected in school.
