English LO: To innovate a story.


Today we are going to plan our new story, using a story mountain. A story mountain is like a story map (but it looks like a mountain).

The rest of the ideas you can take from Supertato.







Vertices are where all the edges meet (the corners).



Faces are a flat or curved surface on a 3d shape.

Edges is where 2 faces meet.




