

Maths: To explore mass (weight)

Today we are beginning to look at mass. This is a new topic for everyone. Year 1 missed out on mass last year due to COVID-19 restrictions, so if you find this a little tricky that is ok.

What is mass?

Mass tells us how much something weighs, or how heavy or light something is.

Sometimes we can feel if an object is heavy or light. But we cannot do this for all objects. For example we know an elephant is heavy, but we cannot pick it up. So, we would use scales to find out its mass.

There are many different types of scales and we use each of them for different things.
